Dear Mr. Butcher:

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ) received a BART waiver request for the referenced site on March 26, 2007.


After the technical review, the ODEQ is approving a waiver for the Anadarko Plant. This waiver is based on facility BART sources which are not expected to cause or contribute to visibility impacts at Class I areas based on submitted modeling and proposed changes as detailed in the application.

The active Title V permit will now be modified to include requirements that the facility comply with the proposed changes/limits in the application within five years of the Regional Haze SIP approval by EPA. Also to be included, will be a requirement that the facility modify the operating permit to incorporate the proposed method of compliance with Appendix Y to Part 51, V. Enforceable Limits. The operating permit shall be modified no later than 6 months prior to the SIP approval.

While ODEQ has approved the waiver, the waiver is subject to EPA and public comment during the Regional Haze State Implementation Program (SIP) approval process.
