In addition, the Department is proposing to revoke Appendix A, Allowable Emissions for Incinerators with Capacities in Excess of 100 lb/hr and Appendix B, Allowable Emissions for Incinerators with Capacities Less than 100 lb/hr. The current provisions of both appendices are proposed to be combined into a new Appendix A, Allowable Particulate Matter Emission Rate for Incinerators.

- B. **OAC 252:100-17. Incinerators, Part 4 [NEW]**

The Department is proposing to add a new Part 4, Biomedical Waste Incinerators, to Subchapter 17,

Incinerators. The new part will incorporate the Best Available Control Technology for this type of incinerator originally established under the authority of Subchapter 41, Control of Emission of Hazardous and Toxic Air Contaminants, which was revoked in 2007. The addition of Part 4 will reestablish the Department's authority to require design and emission standards for biomedical waste incinerators and close a regulatory gap in Part 7 of Subchapter 17.
