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To support the tax credit application, the applicant must include the following information:

1. A description of the current process as it relates to the recycling, reuse or source reduction modification. Include the necessary flow diagrams and engineering drawings (label as "Section 1").
2. A description of the proposed recycling, reuse or source reduction process including flow diagrams and engineering design drawings. The description should include equipment brand names and serial numbers, if known, or design specifications of the exact equipment needed. Also include the life expectancy of each piece of equipment along with the equipment vendor's name and phone number (label as "Section 2").
3. The amount and character of the waste streams both before and after the installation of the process. If there is no current plant process, predict the amount of waste, if any, that will result once the process is in place (label as "Section 3").
4. A justification for the recycling, reuse or source reduction process chosen and a description of the alternatives considered (label as "Section 4").
5. Certification that the process will be used in Oklahoma for hazardous waste generated in Oklahoma. If processing out-of-state wastes, include the percentage of waste that is from Oklahoma (label as "Section 5").
6. Information on any income or savings that will be generated from the installation and operation of the process (label as "Section 6").
7. Actual invoices of installed unit costs or estimates of costs (label as "Section 7").
8. Specify if the process is a proven recycling, reuse or source reduction technology. If it is not, provide an approximate time frame for supplying documentation that the unproven technology will work as expected (label as "Section 8").
9. The date that construction or installation will begin (or began) and the date the process will begin (or began) operation (label as "Section 9").
10. Additional information, if any (label as "Section 10").
