Subject: Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recovery Act

I coordinate Oklahoma's Electronic Waste Program. The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) is notifying all electronics manufacturers who have potential to comply with the Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recovery Act (27A O.S. 2-11-601 et seq.). At this time, it appears that your business meets certain definitions within the Act and/or your business triggers the requirements of the Act with your monitors. You are required to submit an appropriate recovery plan as required by 27A O.S. § 2-11-605 of the Act.

Please submit a direct contact, email, mailing address, and recovery plan to me. Examples of our recovery plans on file can be found on our website: <http://www.deq.state.ok.us/lpdnew/ewasteindex.html>

Oklahoma does not require a registration fee, only a recovery plan. Requirements beyond registration include annual reports and an annual fee due March 1 of every year. I am happy to assist you with your recovery plan or any questions you may have.
