**Google Inc submits the following recovery plan under Oklahoma's Senate Bill Number 1631: "Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recovery Act";**

To meet the requirements of the law, Google Inc shall:

- A. Take responsibility for Google branded covered computer equipment discarded by consumers in Oklahoma at no cost to the consumer.
- B. This will be accomplished through a mail back program as allowed under the "Oklahoma Computer Equipment Recovery Act".
- C. Consumers in Oklahoma shall access Google's program through their website <https://support.google.com/googleplay/go/recycling> Information on how and where to return covered devices is available on the site. A consumer toll-free number is provided on the website should the consumer have any additional questions regarding Google's commitment to environmentally sound management of the electronic materials.
- D. Google will implement this plan and use our recycling partner Sims Recycling Solutions (Sims). Google has a long-standing relationship with Sims for recycling unwanted electronics in multiple states around the country. Sims has 12 facilities around the country. All 12 North American facilities are ISO 9001, 14001, OSHAS 18001 and R2 certified. Under these certifications, the citizens of Oklahoma can be assured their unwanted electronics are handled in the most environmentally sensitive way.
- E. Through the Google website <https://support.google.com/googleplay/go/recycling> consumers will be informed of the laws governing the recycling and reuse of unwanted Google branded computer equipment and how to comply with the requirements of the law.
