#### 1. Describe a brief summary of your current implemented recovery program listing any notable program, or contact, changes.

MRM's compliance program for collection and recycling computer equipment provided a mail back program for consumers who had computer equipment for personal or home business use labeled with MRM consumer brands. A list of the brands and manufacturers participating in the MRM program is below. We have included a list of companies participating in 2012 and those that will be participating in the program year 2013.

Consumers can go to the MRM website to order a pre-paid shipping label to return their computer equipment to an approved MRM recycler. The MRM website provides a map of states on the information page for consumers. Consumers can click on Oklahoma to receive detailed instructions for ordering the prepaid shipping label to be delivered to their home.

Consumers can then drop the item at any location that has UPS pickup to send it in for recycling, including offices that have regular UPS pick up.

Consumers did not have to pay a fee for the mail back recycling service and the program was available to consumers throughout Oklahoma in 2012.

#### 2. Items Collected and Recovered in 2012

MRM received no computer equipment for recycling through the mailback program from Oklahoma in 2012.

Please note that MRM runs a National Voluntary recycling program in Oklahoma. Under this program, consumers can drop off consumer electronics for recycling at no charge for the brands manufactured by specific companies that participate in the MRM National Voluntary program – Mitsubishi, Panasonic, Sanyo, Sharp, Toshiba and VIZIO.

This program is separate from the regularly compliance program for computer equipment. MRM would be happy to provide detail on the voluntary program upon request.
