The current provisions of both appendices are proposed to be combined into a new Appendix A, Allowable Particulate Matter Emission Rate for Incinerators.

The new part will incorporate the Best Available Control Technology for this type of incinerator originally established under the authority of Subchapter 41, Control of Emission of Hazardous and Toxic Air Contaminants, which was revoked in 2007. The addition of Part 4 will reestablish the Department's authority to require design and emission standards for biomedical waste incinerators and close a regulatory gap in Part 7 of Subchapter 17.
