## Biosolids Management in Oklahoma

### Developing a Land Application Biosolids Management Plan

**Biosolids Management Plan** - Any municipality or person seeking authorization to beneficially use biosolids through land application needs to file an application in the form of Biosolids Management Plan with the Department of Environmental Quality. Three (3) complete copies of a biosolids management plan must be filed with the Department.



#### A biosolids management plan for the land application of biosolids must contain the following sections:

- (a) a copy of the permit application (provided by the Department),
- (b) general information,
- (c) source description and processes,
- (d) biosolids characteristics,
- (e) identification of specific sites,
- (f) operations,
- (g) testings, analysis, and monitoring,
- (h) notice, record keeping and reporting,
- (i) closure plan,
- (j) maps, and
- (k) any other information required by the Department.

Detailed requirements listed above can be found in Chapter 606 of the Department's rules or 40 CFR Part 503.
