Reclamation States Emergency Drought Act of 1991

The drought program provides limited funding to assist in relieving the impacts to water supplies due to the drought. Affected entities can propose projects and receive funding per the requirements of the act.

The Bureau of Reclamation does not have a specific format for requesting funds from the drought programs. Certain specific data is required in order for Reclamation to determine if the requests meet the guidelines and provisions of the Drought Act.

The following items should be included in any project proposal:

1. Description of the overall drought problems in the immediate area.
2. Description of the water supply used by the project sponsor.
3. Description of the problems the drought has caused to the entity/project.
4. Description of the impacts the drought has caused to the entity.
5. The proposed plan to solve the problem.
6. Detailed cost estimate for the proposed project.
7. Description of any cost sharing by other agencies, state or federal.
