Hudson Refinery Superfund Site Meeting Scheduled for December

A Hudson Refinery Superfund Site Public Availability session is scheduled for 6 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., Tuesday, December 15, 2009, at Cushing City Hall, located at 100 Judy Adams Boulevard. The public is invited to learn more about cleanup activities underway at the Hudson Refinery Superfund Site in Cushing, Oklahoma.

Representatives from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), the City of Cushing, and Land O' Lakes, Inc. will be available to discuss and answer questions regarding activities underway to address environmental contamination at the site. *This is not a formal meeting.* The public will have the opportunity to talk directly with agency representatives in an informal setting.

Starting in mid to late January 2010, the public will see increasing site activity. Heavy equipment will be brought in to start the clean up. Contaminated soil and pond sediment will be dug up, placed into piles, sampled, and hauled off site for disposal. This work will continue through spring and summer 2010.
