### **Informational Meeting Scheduled to Discuss Hudson Refinery Superfund Site**

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) will hold a meeting from 6 p.m. to 7:30 p.m., Tuesday, September 22, 2009, to update the public on cleanup activities at the Hudson Refinery Superfund site. The Hudson Refinery Superfund Site Availability Session will take place at Cushing City Hall, located at 100 Judy Adams Blvd. in Cushing.

Representatives from EPA, DEQ, the City of Cushing, and Land O' Lakes, Inc. will be available to discuss and answer questions on activities underway to address environmental contamination at the Hudson Refinery site. This is not a formal meeting. The public will have the opportunity to talk directly with agency representatives in an informal setting.
