DEQ Announces Lawn Mower Exchange Program

The Air Quality Division of the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality, in collaboration with Oklahoma State University and Black and Decker, will hold a lawn mower exchange event for Oklahoma City Metro residents.

The lawn mower exchange event will be held at the OSU-OKC Farmer's Market, 400 N. Portland Ave., Oklahoma City from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m., Saturday July 20, 2013. At the event, citizens can exchange old gasoline powered lawn mowers for a \$100 cash voucher toward the purchase of a new electric lawn mower. A limited number of vouchers remain. Vouchers can be redeemed at the Black & Decker service center, located at 8507 S. Western Ave., Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

Vouchers are limited to one per household. All gasoline mowers for exchange must be operationally complete and drained of all gasoline and oil.
