EPA and DEQ Announce Proposed Plan to Address Contamination in Collinsville

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) announce the Proposed Plan to address contamination at the Tulsa Fuel and Manufacturing (TFM) Superfund Site located in Collinsville, Oklahoma.
