Hugo Boil Advisory Lifted

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has announced that follow-up water samples submitted by Hugo, located in Choctaw County, indicate the water is now in compliance with drinking water standards, and the water is safe for human consumption. The boil advisory for Hugo has been lifted.

State and federal regulations require that customers be notified if, at any time, public drinking water is determined to be unsafe.

DEQ is responsible for regulating more than 1,600 public water supplies in the State of Oklahoma. All public water supplies are required to regularly submit samples to DEQ for routine testing to ensure that water is safe for human consumption.
