FUTURE DERA FUNDING OPPORTUNITIES?

- Congress could allocate more funding to DERA programs
- National and State Grant Programs could be announced

CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY FUNDING (CMAQ)

- Flexible funding source for state and local governments to fund transportation projects and programs to help meet the requirements of the Clean Air Act (CAA) and its amendments
- Funds restricted to Central Oklahoma School Districts (at this time)
- Must inform DEQ in VW application if planning to use CMAQ as m

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- Alternative Fuel Refueling or Recharging Infrastructure
- Dedicated Alternative Fuel Vehicles

CONGESTION MITIGATION AND AIR QUALITY FUNDING (CMAQ)

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- Incremental Cost of Vehicle
- 20% Minimum Local Share on fueling equipment
- Vehicle or engine replacement projects must retire the engine block or entire vehicle
