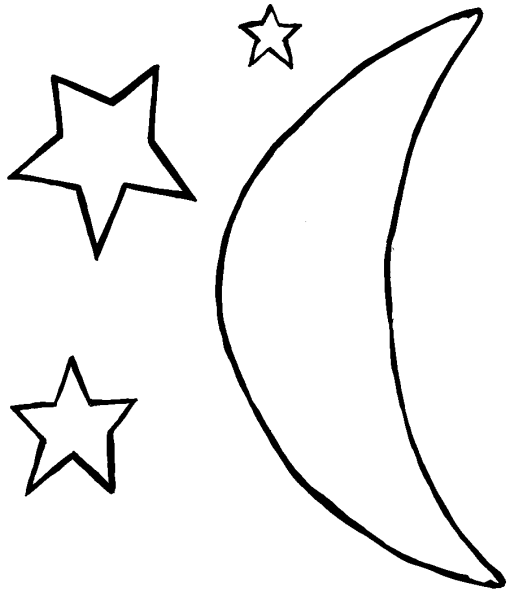




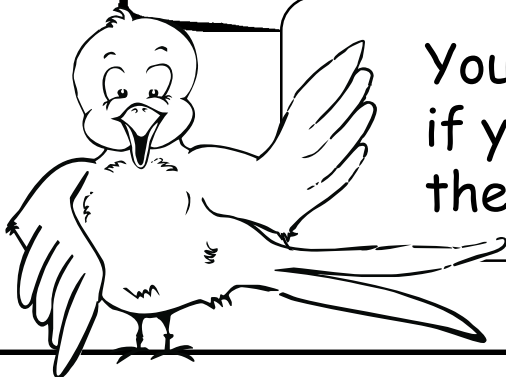
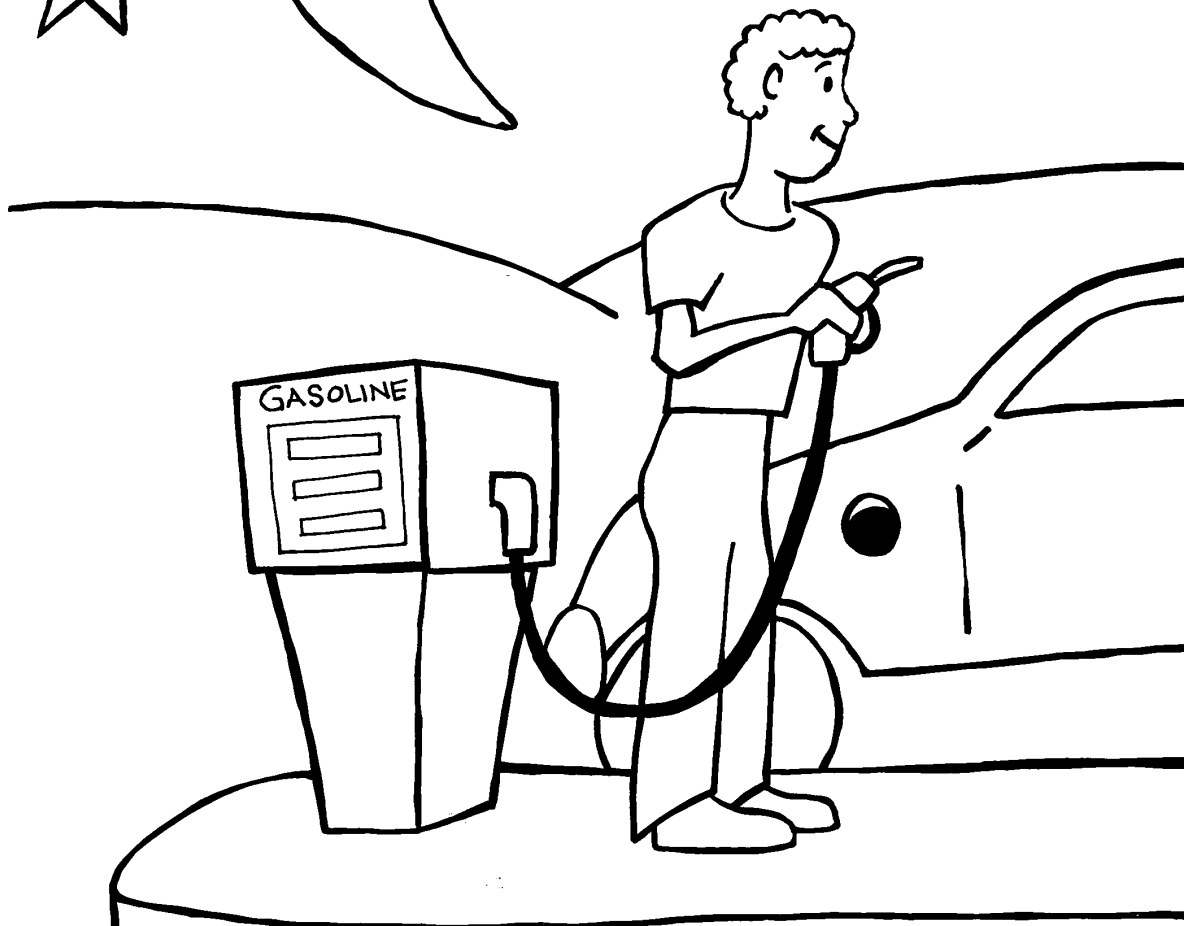
Industry and traffic are

Good Ozone: Way up high

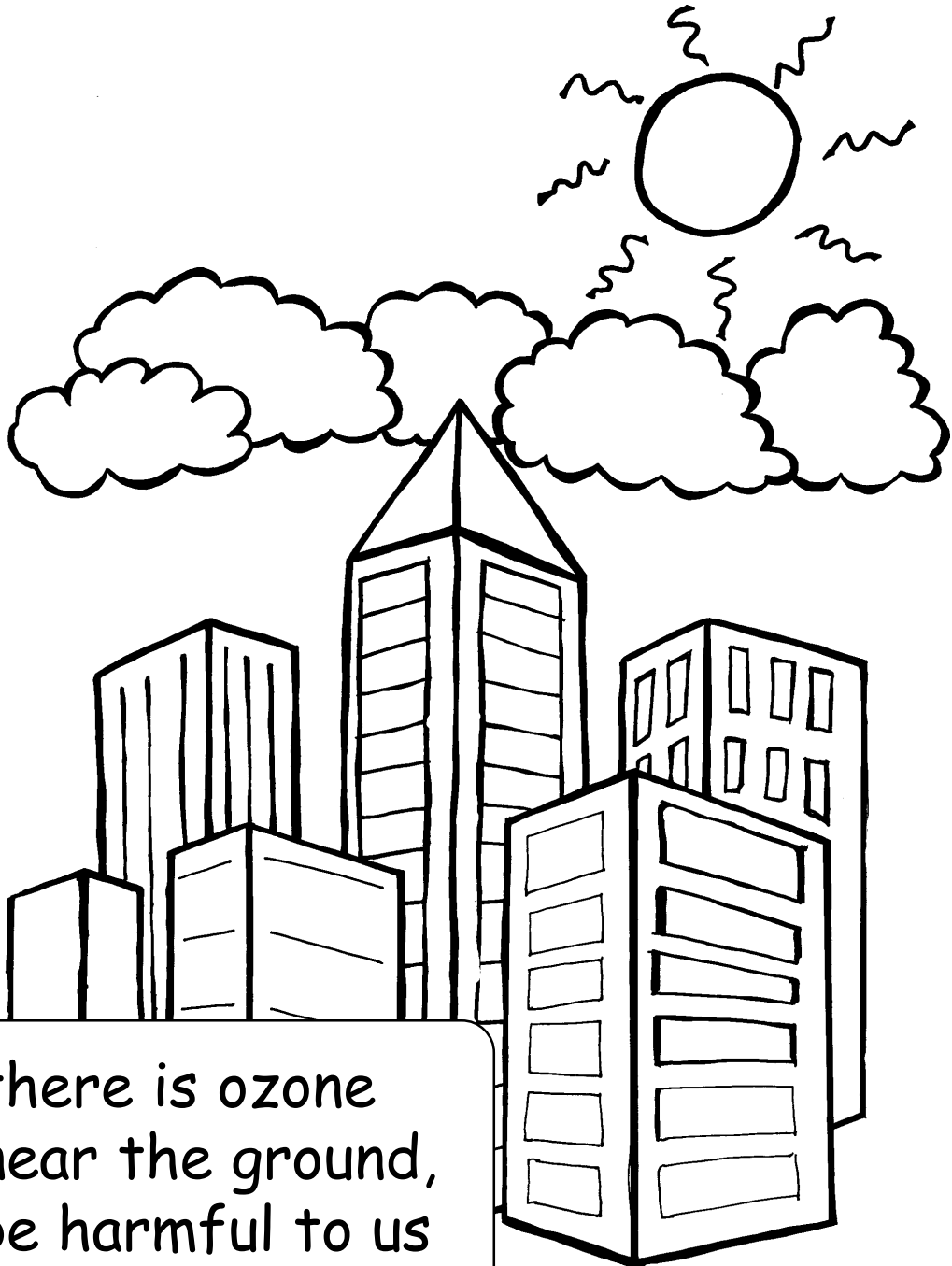


**OZONE

Air pollution such as smog, is often found near cities.

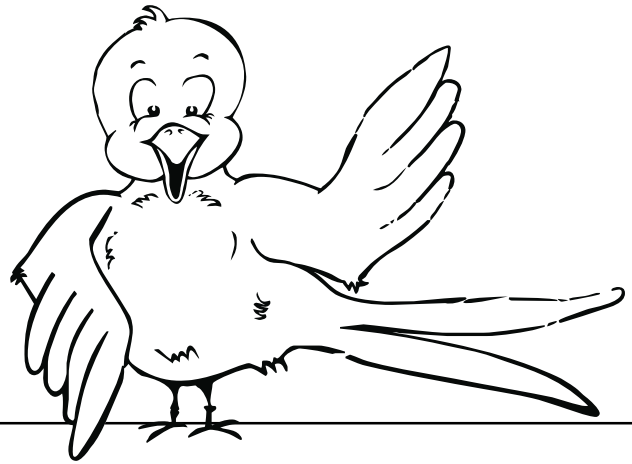


When there is ozone found near the ground, it can be harmful to us if we breathe it.

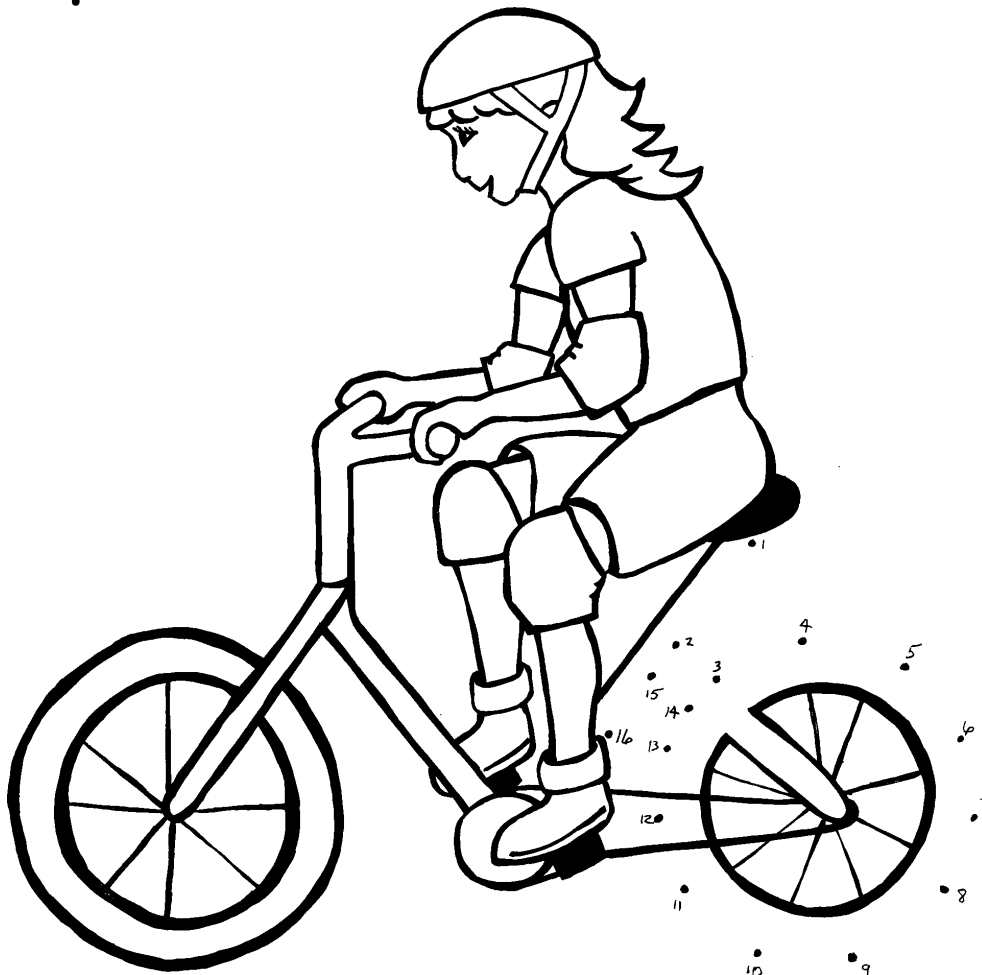
Bad Ozone: When it's nearby

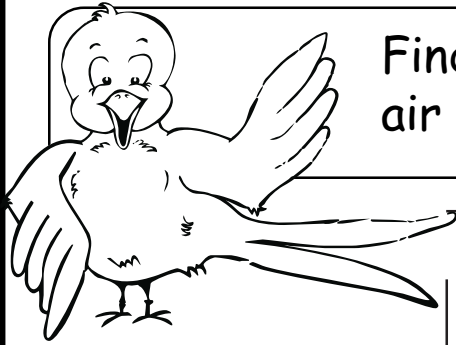

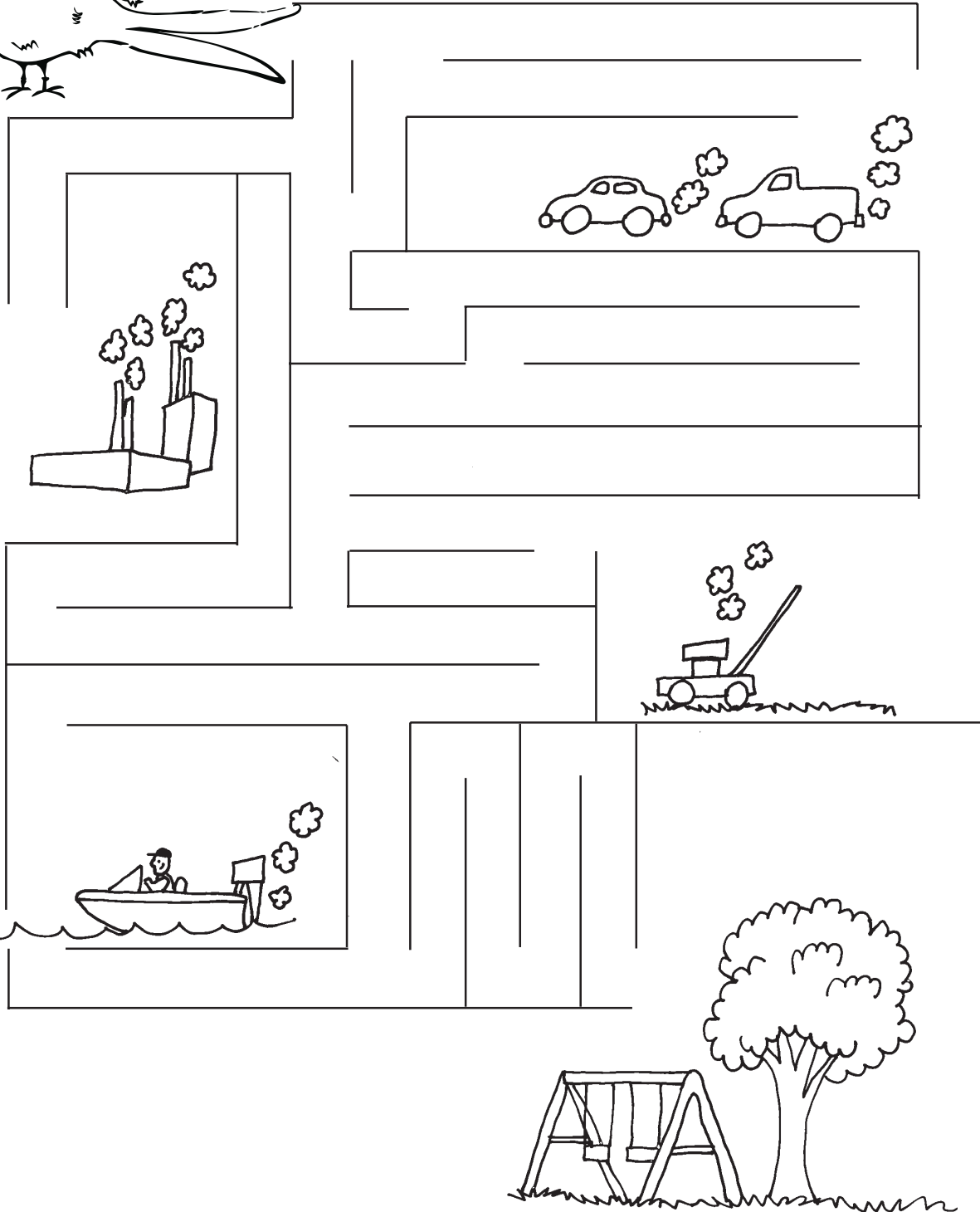

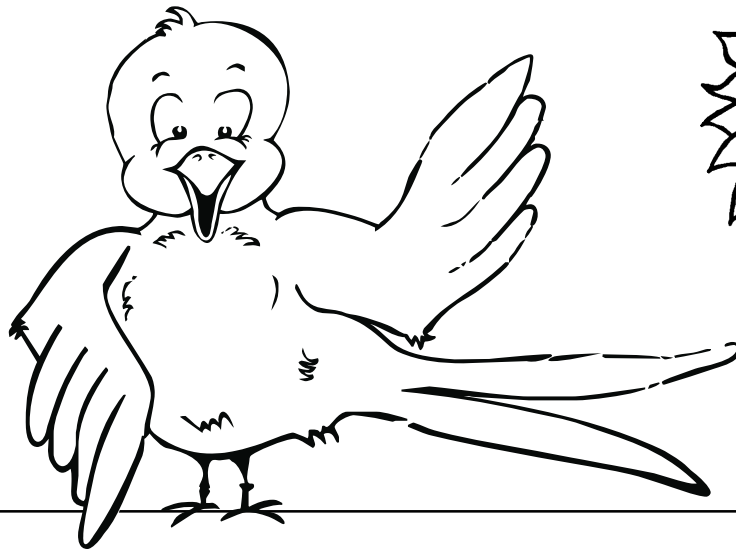

Find your way to the park. Avoid the air pollution sources on your way.

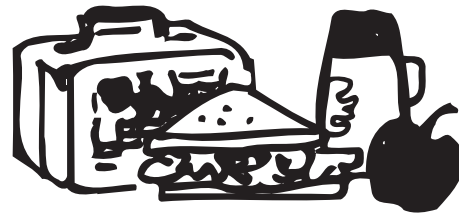




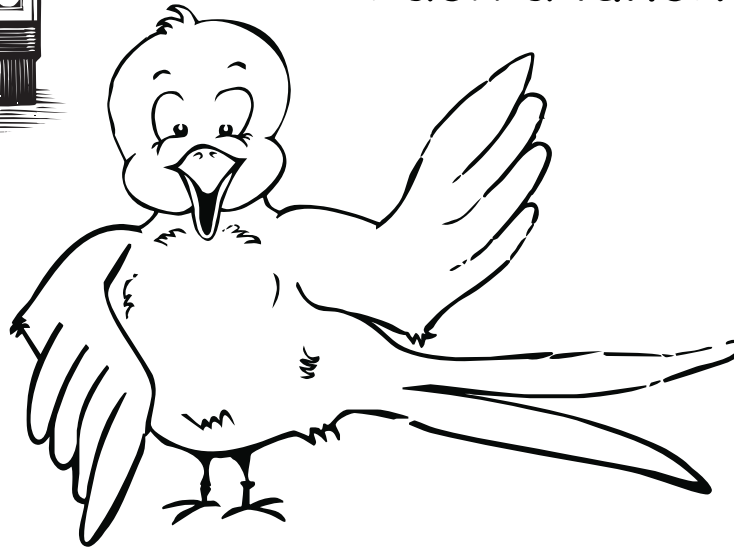

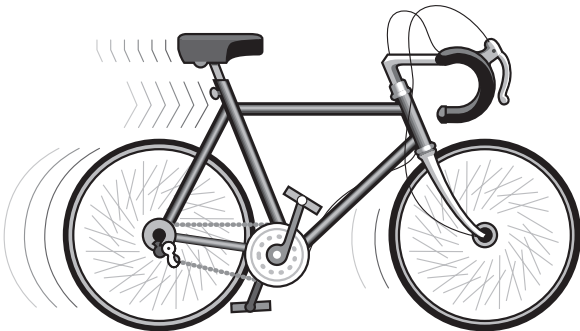
