Notice of Cancellation of Public Hearing

Oklahoma's Section 110 Infrastructure SIP Certification
2010 Primary Sulfur Dioxide NAAQS

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) hereby announces that no request for a public hearing was received by the close of the 30-day notice period (5/1/2014 – 6/1/2014) on the proposed certification that Oklahoma has adequate resources and authority to implement, maintain, and enforce the 2010 Primary Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂) National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). Therefore, the hearing scheduled for Thursday, June 5, 2014 has been cancelled, as provided for in the notice announcing the opportunity to request a public hearing and comment on the proposal. This announcement is in accordance with the public notice requirements of 40 CFR § 51.102.

Written comments on the proposal will be accepted through noon on Thursday, June 5, 2014.
