On October 7, 2022, Keystone Harbor Marina applied for the CVA grant for a new peristaltic pumpout system. The marina was awarded CVA grant funds totaling \$18,165.00 on June 22, 2023. The projected cost of the renovations was \$24,220.00, but the actual cost after the project was completed was \$18,631.34. The marina received 75% of the actual costs, totaling \$13,973.51 in awards.

Mr. Gilbert Welch is retired and works part time for Keystone Harbor Marina. He handles all construction projects with his 30+ years' experience. A marina endures lots of wear and tear from boaters, weather, wildlife, and lake waters. His experience has taught him to create sustainable designs for marinas that can last for years to come. The marina was in dire need of a pump-out system since the previous owners took theirs with them. For this project, Mr. Gilbert chose to install a system that with care, should last 10+ years and keep the marina clean from hundreds of gallons of sewage. The marina plans on building more slips in the future. With the increase in boat traffic, the new pump-out station must handle the additional sewage that will be collected from boaters.

February 14, 2024, Ms. Cheryl Dirck visited Keystone Harbor Marina to look over the new peristaltic pump-out system. The system was within the DEQ regulations and the guidelines of the CVA grant. Ms. Dirck reviewed the receipts, and all parts were accounted for to use for reimbursement. Based on the site visit, Keystone Harbor Marina is eligible for reimbursement of awarded funds under the CVA grant.
