On September 27, 2021, Xtreme Cove Marina applied for a Clean Vessel Act (CVA) grant to replace their pump-out boat. The cost of the pump-out boat is less than projected for the CVA grant. The total cost of the pump-out boat is \$157,125.00. The CVA grant awards Xtreme Cove Marina 75% of that total project cost. The 75% awarded amount to the marina is \$117,843.75.

Lake Eufaula is Oklahoma's largest lake located in southeastern Oklahoma near the city of Eufaula. Lake Eufaula has multiple marinas available for boaters to enjoy the wide variety of activities on the water and shore. Xtreme Cove Marina is open all year and services the Lake Eufaula area. The marina has the capability to hold up to 423 boats and approximately 75% of the boats at the marina contain on-board sanitary facilities and over 200 boats are greater than 20 feet. The closest pump-out facility is approximately five miles from the marina. Ron Henry purchased the marina on January 1, 2021. His goal was to renovate and upgrade the marina's existing systems to help prevent down times for maintenance, leaks, or catastrophic failures that may occur over time due to normal aging of systems. Xtreme Cove Marina promotes keeping the waterways clean of vessel sewage and to prevent chemicals used to treat vessel sewage from leaking into Lake Eufaula. They educate slip renters and boaters to protect marine life and uncontrolled algae growth from such chemicals and sewage. The marina believes in protecting the environment and educating boaters to keep Lake Eufaula pristine and clean from human impact.

October 16, 2023, Cheryl Dirck visited the marina for a site assistance visit to verify the new pump-out boat. The project was within DEQ regulations. The new pump-out boat meets the requirements for CVA reimbursement. Ms. Dirck reviewed the receipts, and all dates and costs are within the parameters of the CVA grant timeline. Xtreme Cove Marina is eligible for their awarded CVA grant funds.
