9. Rulemaking - OAC 252:100 Air Pollution Control

- A. The Department is proposing to amend OAC 252:100, Subchapters 37, 39, and Appendix N to provide the aerospace industry with updated requirements that better reflect current aerospace industry coating formulations and practice, and to make the rules applicable statewide. This rulemaking would ensure the aerospace industry in Oklahoma has the opportunity to operate with standards specific to the industry and consistent with rules already in place for Tulsa County to reduce the formation of ozone.
- B. The Department is proposing to amend 252:100-1-2, Statutory definitions, to correct a statutory citation and update the latest statutory publication date. The Department is also proposing to amend 252:100-1-3, Definitions, to add, clarify, and correct definitions.
