Soil profilers and installers need to stay for all four modules. Haulers/pumpers just needing two hours of CEUs only need to attend the first two modules.

Fees and Signing-up for the Class:

Like in previous years, the classes will be offered at a **fee rate which is lower than the industry norm** of \$30 per CEU hour. The fees for the CEU classes are as follows:

- Four Hours of CEUs for Installers and Soil Profilers: \$70 (\$17.5 per hour)
- Two hours of CEUs for Pumpers: \$35 (\$17.5 per hour)
