

**OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY
NOTICE - APPLICATION FILED**

Application filed. A solid waste Tier II application has been filed with the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ).

Applicant: The applicant is the City of Ada, 231 South Townsend, Ada, OK 74820.

Type of final permit or permit action being sought: The applicant seeks a new permit.

Facility location: The City of Ada Transfer Station is proposed to be located at County Road 1520, Ada, OK. See legal description below.*

Activities to be regulated if the application is approved: The City of Ada Transfer Station will accept municipal solid waste from residential and commercial facilities and will transfer this waste to large semi-trucks and trailers that can transport the waste to a DEQ approved landfill. It is anticipated that the facility will accept between 150 and 300 tons per day. All operations will be conducted inside of a large building that will be constructed on-site.

Statutes and Rules: The DEQ will review the application for compliance with the Environmental Quality Code, including the Solid Waste Management Act, Title 27A of Oklahoma Statutes, Section 2-10-101, *et seq.*, and the rules of the DEQ, Oklahoma Administrative Code, Title 252, Chapters 4 and 515.

Permitting procedures explained: Opportunities for public comment on this application will begin when notice is given that the DEQ has completed its review of the application and has prepared either a draft permit or a draft denial. At that time, written comments may be sent and a public meeting for oral comments may be requested. The application may be reviewed at the locations listed below and may be revised by the applicant as the DEQ review progresses.

***Legal description of site: LEGAL DESCRIPTION:** A tract of land lying in the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Four (4) North, Range Five (5) East of the Indian Meridian, Pontotoc County, Oklahoma, and being more particularly described as follows: COMMENCING at the northeast corner of the NW/4 of said Section 24; THENCE South 00°38'37" East, along the east line of said NW/4, a distance of 275.00 feet; THENCE South 89°21'23" West, perpendicular to said east line, a distance of 81.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; THENCE South 00°38'37" East, parallel with said east line, a distance of 359.50 feet; THENCE South 89°21'23" West, perpendicular to said east line, a distance of 438.00 feet; THENCE North 00°38'37" West, parallel with said east line, a distance of 359.50 feet; THENCE North 89°21'23" East, perpendicular to said east line, a distance of 438.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING. Said described tract of land contains an area of 157,461 square feet or 3.6148 acres, more or less.
