On February 8, 2021, the Land Protection Division of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received the above referenced permit renewal application dated February 4, 2021, for the renewal of the Central Plains Cement Company (CPCC) Tulsa Cement Operations Permit. In accordance with Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 252:205-21-4(a)(2), the required application fee was received in the amount of \$7,500. In accordance with OAC 252:4-7-13(c) and (d), Tulsa Cement provided DEQ with a draft notice of filing on February 5, 2021, and published the approved notice in The Claremore Daily Progress on March 7, 2021. The required affidavit of publication was submitted on March 11, 2021.

The renewal application was reviewed for administrative completeness in accordance with Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR) parts 264 and 270, the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act (27A O.S. §§ 2-7-101 *et seq.*), OAC 252:4 and OAC 252:205. After review, DEQ has determined the application to be administratively complete. Administrative completeness does not constitute a determination of technical adequacy. A detailed technical review of the application will be conducted by DEQ to ascertain its technical completeness. Tulsa Cement will be notified of the result of the technical review once it is completed.
