NOTICE OF FILING TIER II APPLICATION FOR CLASS V GEOTHERMAL WELL PERMIT

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on April 27, 2023, Blue Cedar Energy and the University of Oklahoma ("OU") filed with the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality ("DEQ") a Tier II Permit Application ("Application") for a Class V Geothermal Well.

The Permit, if approved, would authorize Blue Cedar Energy and OU to repurpose, operate, maintain, and monitor an oil and gas well in Grady County, Oklahoma for the purpose of extracting geothermal energy. The well will be classified as a Class V injection well under DEQ jurisdiction in accordance with Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations §144.80(e). The project will be developed near Tuttle, Oklahoma in Section 11-T09N-R06W.
