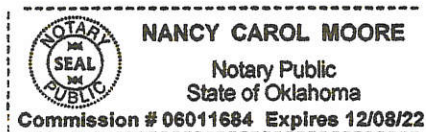

OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY NOTICE - APPLICATION FILED

Application filed. A solid waste Tier III application has been filed with the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). Interested persons now have the opportunity to meet with the DEQ and learn how and where they may participate in the permitting process.

Applicant: The applicant is Miller Environmental Transfer, LLC, 4231 S. Elwood Ave, Tulsa, OK 74107.

Type of final permit or permit action being sought: The applicant seeks a new solid waste processing permit.

Facility location: The Material Processing Facility is proposed to be located at 3800 S. Elwood Ave, Tulsa, OK 74107. See legal description below.*

Activities to be regulated if the application is approved: The applicant is requesting authorization to construct, operate, maintain and close a solid waste processing facility service to industrial clients to reduce the volume of non-hazardous industrial waste being land disposed by processing the materials into a beneficial use such as recycling, recovery, reuse and energy conversion. All material processing will be conducted inside a fully enclosed Process Building. No industrial materials will be disposed of onsite and will be transported from the site to fully approved end users or disposal facilities. The proposed facility would be approved to process up to 156 cubic yards of solid waste per day and up to 100,000 gallons of liquid wastes per day.

Statutes and Rules: The DEQ will review the application for compliance with the Environmental Quality Code, including the Solid Waste Management Act, Title 27A of Oklahoma Statutes, Section 2-10-101, et seq., and the rules of the DEQ, Oklahoma Administrative Code, Title 252, Chapters 4 and 515.
