SECTION F-1 – SECURITY PLAN

1.0 SECURITY

In accordance with 40 CFR 264.14, 270.14(b)(4), and OAC 252:205-3-2(f), the Systech Tulsa plant has developed a security plan in conjunction with the CPCC facility that includes a 24-hour surveillance system and warning signs to control entry into the plant. CPCC personnel are on site 24 hours per day and use hand-held radios, portable telephones, and the plant's internal telephone system to provide an immediate means of communication if a breach of security occurs. Visitor access to the Systech plant is controlled by requiring all visitors to register at the CPCC main office, to wear a badge identifying the person, and to be escorted by a Systech plant employee at all times. Plant employees are instructed to stop and question unescorted visitors about their presence. Remote areas of the CPCC plant have perimeter fencing to prevent unauthorized access.

1.1 24-hour Surveillance System

The active area of the Systech facility is relatively small, aiding in surveillance of the area. The number of persons authorized to work in the waste management area is limited; therefore, unauthorized persons would be identified quickly.

A camera and monitor provide continuous surveillance and aids in identifying unauthorized entry or emergency conditions. The surveillance system is monitored by the CPCC Control Room personnel 24-hours per day when the kiln is in operation. In the event that the control room is not manned (e.g., annual plant shutdowns for maintenance) and Systech personnel are not on site, valves on the FQW tanks are locked to prevent unauthorized access to the material.

1.2 Warning Signs

Signs bearing the legend "DANGER--UNAUTHORIZED PERSONNEL KEEP OUT" or similar language and "DANGER--NO SMOKING" are posted around the Systech tank farm and truck off-loading area. These signs are legible from a distance of at least 25 feet and visible from all angles of approach to the facility.

1.3 Waiver

The Systech Tulsa plant does not request a waiver from security requirements under 40 CFR 264.14(a).
