

SITE SUMMARY
BARTLETT-COLLINS GLASS (DKirk)

Location: 620 South Linden Street in Sapulpa, Creek County, Oklahoma.

Background: The site is improved with a large industrial facility used as a glass manufacturing plant for approximately 100 years. The facility was purchased from Bartlett-Collins in 1982 by Indiana Glass, Lancaster Colony Corporation.

Air: There are no known air quality issues.

Soil: There are soils impacted with arsenic and Total Petroleum Hydrocarbons (TPH) on-site.

Surface Water: The nearby stream to the west tested very low levels of arsenic.

Groundwater: The groundwater has been impacted by arsenic and TPH.

Water Wells: There are six domestic wells within a one-mile radius of the site but none closer than approximately 0.65 miles. Depths range from 98 to 215 feet.

Vapor Intrusion to Indoor Air: There are no known indoor vapor intrusion issues at this site.

Key Questions:

- **Has the groundwater contaminant plume been adequately evaluated and delineated?** Yes
- **Has the site been sampled for an adequate list of analytes?** Yes
- **Does soil or waste need to be cleaned up?** Yes, feasibility study in progress.
- **Has the surface water been sampled?** Yes
- **Has soil at the site been cleaned up to levels protective of groundwater?** No.
