

Former 3-M / Eastman Kodak Facility

Location: 2720 E Frontage Rd, Weatherford, OK 73096

Background: The facility was originally the 3-M plant which transitioned to Imation in 1996. In 2002 Kodak Polychrome Graphics (KPG) purchased the north half of the Imation plant. Eastman Kodak Company purchased KPG in 2005.

Air: No known issues.

Soil: There have been areas of soil remediation.

Surface Water: There is an intermittent stream on the property east of the facility on undeveloped land. No issues have been identified relating to the surface waters.

Groundwater: Groundwater has been impacted with chlorinated solvents. There has been an active pump and treat system in place since mid-1990s that continues to date.

Private/ Public Wells: In 1991, eleven (11) municipal water supply wells and eight (8) private domestic wells were identified within a one-mile radius of the site.

Vapor Intrusion to Indoor Airspace: Not an issue.
