Dear Mr. Golladay:

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received the Tier III Modification Application (Modification) for Enso Solutions Composting Facility (Enso Solutions), dated November 11, 2020. The notice of filing was published in *The Oklahoman* on November 25, 2020; no requests for a process meeting were made. The purpose of the modification is to allow Enso Solutions to accept a new feedstock type and increase the volume of feedstock at the facility.

DEQ issued a notice of deficiency (NOD) on January 12, 2021. Additional information was submitted via email on January 22, January 26, March 22, March 23, March 30, and April 12, 2021. DEQ found that the deficiencies were resolved, and the application was administratively complete. Subsequently, in accordance with Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 252:4-7-8, the Solid Waste Permitting Unit conducted a technical completeness review with respect to the application. DEQ now finds Enso Solution's application to be technically complete.

Enclosed is a copy of the Draft Permit for your review, together with instructions for the preparation, publication, and certification of the legal notice as required with all Tier III applications. As noted in the instructions, please submit a draft of the legal notice to DEQ for review, prior to publication.
