Dear Mr. Sparks:

On February 5, 2021, the Land Protection Division of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received the above referenced permit renewal application (Application) dated February 4, 2021, for the renewal of the Systech Environmental Corporation (Systech) Operations Permit. The Application was reviewed for administrative and technical completeness in accordance with Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR) parts 264 and 270, the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act, 27A O.S. §§ 2-7-101 *et seq.*, Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 252:4 and 252:205. DEQ determined the Application to be administratively complete on May 13, 2021, and technically complete on October 13, 2022.

DEQ issued a courtesy draft of the permit on October 13, 2022, for Systech to review and submit comments. Systech provided comments on the courtesy draft permit in correspondence dated November 16, 2022. DEQ reviewed the comments and made minor revisions to the draft permit as requested.

The enclosed draft permit has been finalized for public review and comment. A Plain Language Notice that Systech agreed to publish in a local newspaper is also enclosed. Systech is required to publish notice of opportunity to comment and request a public meeting on the draft permit in at least one (1) local newspaper of general circulation. Concurrently, a notice should be broadcast on a local radio station. These notices will announce the opening of a forty-five (45) day comment period. Additionally, Systech is to send a notice of the draft permit to all persons on the facility mailing list and to appropriate state and local government agencies as specified in 40 CFR 124.10(c)(1)(ix) and (x). Subsequently, proofs of publication and broadcasts must be furnished to DEQ within twenty (20) days after the date of publication pursuant to OAC 252:4-7-13(d).
