OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY NOTICE – DRAFT PERMIT and PUBLIC MEETING

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality ("DEQ") received an application for a Tier III solid waste permit to process non-hazardous solid waste at the Keota AD 1 facility to be located at 21405 OK-9, Keota, OK 74941, see legal description below. The application was filed by Keota AD 1, LLC, on June 21, 2024. The application was subsequently revised with the final updated application received on February 21, 2025.

DEQ has tentatively found that the application meets the requirements of Title 27A of the Oklahoma Statutes, Section 2-1-101, *et seq.*, Section 2-10-101, *et seq.*, and rules of the DEQ, Oklahoma Administrative Code ("OAC"), Title 252, Chapters 4 and 515, and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The draft permit and its conditions propose to construct, operate, maintain and close a solid waste processing facility on an approximately 20-acre tract. The facility will accept 185-275 tons per day of organic non-hazardous solid and liquid waste, generally from locations less than 50 miles from the facility. The wastes will be processed by anaerobic digestion into natural gas and solid and liquid digestate. The natural gas will be piped into a biogas upgrader and injected into a gathering pipeline on site, and the solid and liquid digestate will be disposed of at a permitted solid waste disposal facility unless another method is approved by DEQ.

The application, draft permit, and related documents may be reviewed during normal business hours at the Central Records Office, DEQ, located on the 2nd floor of the DEQ building at 707 North Robinson, P. The public comment period will remain open until the close of the public meeting. The purpose of the public meeting is for any person to submit oral or written statements and data concerning the draft permit.
