

**Application filed.** A solid waste Tier III application has been filed with the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (ODEQ). Interested persons now have the opportunity to meet with the ODEQ and learn how and where they may participate in the permitting process.

**Applicant:** The applicant is Southern Oklahoma Regional Disposal Landfill which is owned and operated by Southern Oklahoma Regional Disposal, Inc.

**Type of final permit or permit action being sought:** The applicant seeks to modify an existing permit.

**Facility location:** The Southern Oklahoma Regional Disposal Landfill is located at 31 Sord Drive, approximately 4 miles east of Ardmore, Oklahoma. See legal description below.\*

**Activities to be regulated if the application is approved:** The applicant seeks to modify the existing permit to expand the current permitted boundary by 80 acres to the north and east. Facility operations will continue in the same manner as the existing facility. The average volume of waste received daily at the facility is not anticipated to increase as a result of this permit modification.

**Statutes and Rules:** The ODEQ will review the application for compliance with the Environmental Quality Code, including the Solid Waste Management Act, Title 27A of Oklahoma Statutes, Section 2-10-101, et seq., and the rules of the ODEQ, Oklahoma Administrative Code,
