

**OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY
NOTICE - APPLICATION FILED**

Application filed. A Tier III solid waste permit modification application has been filed with the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). Interested persons now have the opportunity to meet with DEQ and learn how and where they may participate in the permitting process.

Applicant: The applicant is the American Environmental Landfill, Inc., 1420 W. 35th Street, Suite B. Tulsa, Oklahoma. See legal description below.*

Type of final permit or permit action being sought: The applicant seeks to modify an existing permit.

Facility location: The American Environmental Landfill is located at 212 North 177th West Avenue, Sand Springs, Oklahoma.

Activities to be regulated if the application is approved: Solid Waste, Household Waste, Commercial Solid Waste, Construction and Demolition Waste, Non-Hazardous Industrial Solid Waste, Contaminated Soil, Municipal and Industrial Sludge, Non-Friable Asbestos, Friable Asbestos, Liquid Wastes, Special Waste, and other waste deemed by the DEQ as non-hazardous and can be disposed of in a Municipal Solid Waste Landfill will be disposed of at the American Environmental Landfill.

This Tier III Permit application proposes to laterally expand the permit boundary 203-acres, establish base grades for such area, and permit a leachate storage impoundment.

This Tier III Permit application includes one variance request per Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 252:515-3-32. The variance request is for the location of the permit boundary expansion within an area designated as alluvium or terrace deposits, OAC 252:515-5-51(a)(1). A portion of the proposed permit boundary expansion area may overlap the area identified as terrace deposits on the referenced map. However, the waste disposal boundary does not overlay the terrace or alluvium deposits located along the southern boundary of the property as identified by a subsurface investigation.

If this Tier III Permit application is approved, the permitted area of the existing landfill will be increased 203-acres resulting in approximately 425-acres of permitted area. The capacity increase from such will be 55,765,504 cubic yards. The total capacity of the permitted landfill will then be 79,941,120 cubic yards. Groundwater and explosive gas monitoring will be expanded to incorporate the expansion area. Stormwater drainage structures will be constructed to control surface water discharges to the waters of the state.

Statutes and Rules: DEQ will review the application for compliance with the Environmental Quality Code, including the Solid Waste Management Act, Title 27A of Oklahoma Statutes, Section 2-10-101, *et seq.*, and the rules of DEQ, Oklahoma Administrative Code, Title 252, Chapters 4 and 515.

Permitting procedures explained: On request, a representative of DEQ will chair a meeting to explain the steps of DEQ's permitting process to interested persons. If a meeting is requested, there will be discussion explaining when oral and written public comments can be made on the proposal. Administrative hearing opportunities will also be discussed. To request a process meeting, send a written request to the DEQ representative named below within 30 days after the date this notice is published. Please note this is not a meeting for protests. Its purpose is to advise interested persons on participation opportunities during the permitting process. The Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) and the East Half (E/2) of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) and the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of the Northwest Quarter (NW/4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of Section 36, Township 20 North, Range 10 East of the Indian Meridian, Osage County, Oklahoma.

AND

A tract of land being a part of the West Half (W/2) of Section 36 and the East Half (E/2) of Section 35, Township 20 North, Range 10 East of the Indian Meridian, Osage County, Oklahoma.

AND

The South 50.00 feet of the East 1165.11 feet of the Southeast Quarter (SE/4) of the Northeast Quarter (NE/4) of Section 36, Township 20 North, Range 10 East of the Indian Meridian, Osage County, Oklahoma.
