

PERMIT MODIFICATION ISSUED BY THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY

In accordance with 27A O.S. § 2-14-304(F), and effective on this date, notice is hereby given that the East Quarry Construction and Demolition Landfill has been issued a final Tier III Solid Waste Permit Modification by the Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). East Quarry Construction and Demolition Landfill is located in the SW/4 of Section 9, and in part of the NW/4 of Section 16, Township 20 North, Range 14 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

The final permit allows East Quarry Construction and Demolition Landfill to laterally expand the permit boundary and the waste disposal area to dispose of construction and demolition waste in two areas totaling approximately 55.76 acres. East Quarry Construction and Demolition Landfill is authorized to operate, close, and monitor during post-closure the construction and demolition landfill in conformity with the Solid Waste Management Act (27A O.S. § 2-10-101 *et seq.*) and the rules of the DEQ (Oklahoma Administrative Code Title 252, Chapters 4 and 517).
