Mr. Hoyle called the meeting to order. Ms. Fields called roll and confirmed that there was a quorum.

Mr. Hoyle called for a motion to approve the December 7, 2016 Minutes. Mr. Niswander moved to approve the December 7, 2016 Minutes and Mr. Driscoll made the second. Approval by members was with “aye”. No one opposed.

Commission Status Reports: Ms. McKelvey stated that the HMEP 2017-2018 continuing applications are being processed and has to be submitted by the end of May. Also, Region VI EPA LEPC Workshops were cancelled due to funding, but there may be a possibility of rescheduling March through May of next year. The OSU mid-year training reports from September 30, 2016 through April 30, 2017 were 907 first responders that had been trained, which is 12,044 hours of training for first responders. Ms. McKelvey also spoke on other training updates underway. Ms. Murphy and Mr. Bergman provided a handout on the Data Management Report and gave an update on the report.
