Dear Mr. McClanahan:

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received the Tier III permit modification application for the lateral expansion of the East Quarry Construction and Demolition Landfill (East Quarry) permit boundary on July 6, 2018. Pursuant to 27A O.S. §2-14-301(A), the application Notice of Filing was published in the *Tulsa World* in Tulsa, Oklahoma, on July 10, 2018.

DEQ determined the application to be administratively complete on September 27, 2018 and technically complete on May 20, 2019. The next step in the permitting process was the preparation of a "Draft Permit" and the opportunity for public comments and a public meeting request. 27A O.S. § 2-14-302 required APAC-Central, Inc. to publish "Notice of Draft Permit Modification" in one newspaper local to the site and allow 30 days for public comment and for a public meeting request. The "Notice of Draft Permit Modification" was published in the *Tulsa World*, Tulsa, Oklahoma, on May 31, 2019. No comments or requests for a public meeting were received. The next step in the permitting process is the preparation of a "Proposed Permit Modification" and the opportunity for a person directly affected by the facility to request an administrative hearing. The "Notice of Proposed Permit Modification" will be published in the *Tulsa World* in Tulsa, Oklahoma for compliance with 27A O.S. § 2-14-304(C).

Enclosed is a copy of the Proposed Permit Modification for your review, together with instructions for the preparation, publication and certification of the legal notice as required for all Tier III Proposed Permits. As noted in the instructions, please submit a draft of the legal notice to DEQ for review, prior to publication.
