NOTICE - DRAFT
PERMIT**

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has received an application for a solid waste Tier III Permit Modification to expand the current permitted boundary by 80 acres at the Southern Oklahoma Regional Disposal Landfill, 31 Sord Drive, Ardmore, Oklahoma, located in the S/2 of the S/2 of the SE/4 of Section 13, Township 4 South, Range 2 East and the NE/4 of Section 24, Township 4 South, Range 2 East, Carter County, Oklahoma. The application was filed by Southern Oklahoma Regional Disposal, Inc.

The DEQ has found that the application meets the requirements of Title 27A of the Oklahoma Statutes, Section 2-1-101, *et seq.*, Section 2-10-101, *et seq.* and rules of the DEQ, Oklahoma Administrative Code, Title 252, Chapters 4 and 515, and has prepared a draft permit for public review.

The draft permit and its conditions propose to increase the permit boundary from 120 acres to 200 acres, revise previously permitted base grade designs for Cells 3-6, establish base grade designs for the new area and permit a leachate storage impoundment.

The application, the draft permit, and related documents may be reviewed during normal business hours at the Office of Central Records, Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality, located on the 2nd floor of the DEQ building at 707 North Robinson, P.O. Box 1677, Oklahoma City, OK 73101-1677.

If the DEQ determines, based on the requests it receives, that there is significant degree of public interest in the draft permit, it will schedule a public meeting and provide notice of the date, time and place.

Written comments and requests for a public meeting must be received by the DEQ within 30 days after the date of this publication at the DEQ address given above or electronically on the DEQ website.
