### **Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality Notice of Proposed Permit Conditions For a Hazardous Waste Management Facility**

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality has reviewed a permit renewal application submitted by Systech Environmental Corporation to conduct hazardous waste management activities at its facility. The application was filed on February 4, 2021. The facility is located within the Southwest Quarter of Section 22, Township 20 North, Range 14 East of the Indian Base and Meridian, Rogers County, Oklahoma, and is within the corporate limits of the City of Tulsa. The street address for the facility is 2701 N. 145<sup>th</sup> East Avenue Tulsa, Oklahoma 74116.

The Oklahoma Department of Environmental Quality has made a tentative determination to renew the permit.

The draft permit and its conditions propose that Systech Environmental Corporation continues receiving, blending, and storing hazardous waste fuel. The permit would be issued under the authority of the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act and the Federal Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
