On February 8, 2021, the Land Protection Division of the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) received the above referenced permit renewal application (Application) dated February 4, 2021, for the renewal of the Tulsa Cement LLC DBA Central Plains Cement Company (CPCC) RCRA Operations Permit. The Application was reviewed for administrative completeness in accordance with Title 40 of the Code of Federal Regulations (40 CFR) parts 264 and 270, the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act (27A O.S. §§ 2-7-101 et seq.), Oklahoma Administrative Code (OAC) 252:4 and OAC 252:205, and DEQ determined the Application to be administratively complete on May 13, 2021.

DEQ reviewed the Application for technical adequacy in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations and issued a notice of deficiency (NOD) in correspondence dated February 1, 2022. DEQ received CPCC's NOD response on March 30, 2022. CPCC has appropriately addressed each NOD item and has provided all of the requested information. In addition to the NOD responses, other revisions were made to the Waste Analysis Plan and Contingency Plan to correct typographical errors, provide clarification of information, update emergency contact information, and include information on the management of hazardous kiln brick. DEQ has completed its technical review of the Application and all supplemental information and finds the Application to be technically complete.

Enclosed is a courtesy draft of the permit for CPCC to review and submit comments. The enclosed courtesy draft also provides suggested language for the public notices and additional instructions for publishing and broadcasting the notices. These notices will announce the opening of a forty-five (45) day comment period during which the public may comment on the permit language or request that a public meeting be held. These notices are for your review and not to be published at this time.
