RESULTS

Below are the results from the first round of testing of drinking water for lead that was conducted at Southwest Oklahoma Community Action Group - Mangum Head Start on October 24, 2024. Overall, six (6) outlets were tested resulting in a total of twelve (12) samples being sent to the lab.

- Eight (8) samples had no detectable level of lead.
- Four (4) samples had a low detection of lead between 1.0 and 14.9 μ g/L.
- Zero (0) samples had a high detection of lead equal to or above 15.0 μg/L.
