- Survey conducted of Clean Water State Revolving Fund eligible projects for facilities, entities, and persons to comply with the American Clean Water Act.
- Survey is conducted every four years.
- Produces "\$" of capitol improvement projects ("needs") for various types of improvements for compliance with the Clean Water Act.
- Includes Wastewater Treatment, Nonpoint Source, Collection System, Stormwater, and other miscellaneous needs associated with those listed above.

## **Overview**

- Once the data entry is completed, a report is generated and sent to Congress. This report is used to allocate funding to states based upon the reported needs.
  - Federal CWSRF Allocation.
  - Grants Programs.
  - Grant/Loan Programs.
- Oklahoma Reported over 2.6 Billion dollars of documented needs in the 2012 CWNS (Official Report Pending).
  - \$0.00 in Stormwater Needs.
