Please complete each item on the following sheets. DEQ cannot process the permit ownership transfer until a completed request has been received. This request should be completed by the new owner of a permitted facility.

- Item 1: Enter the facility's wastewater permit number. If you do not know your permit number, please contact the Industrial Permitting Section at (405) 702-8100. Note that expired permits cannot be transferred.
- Item 2: Enter the name of the transferor company.
- Item 3: Enter the name of the transferee company.
- Item 4: Give the complete mailing address of the office where correspondence should be sent. This is often not the same address as is used to designate the location of the facility.
- Item 5: Enter the name the facility will be operating under. If the facility name will not change as a result of this transfer, then enter the name the facility is currently operating under.
- Item 6: Attach a copy of the transfer agreement between the transferor and transferee. A template transfer agreement is included for your convenience on the next page. You are not required to use this template.
- Item 7: Provide a certificate of good standing from the Oklahoma Secretary of State and Articles of Organization. If you operate your business as a sole proprietor, select the appropriate check box. Sole proprietors are not required to register with the Oklahoma Secretary of State.
- Item 8: Certify that you have sufficient financial capability to maintain the permit and, if necessary, undergo closure. Maintenance costs can include annual permit fees, renewal fees, treatment equipment upkeep, treatment chemicals, wastewater testing, impoundment berm and liner maintenance, and repairing damage from floods or other severe weather events. Closure costs could include removal and disposal of wastewater, sludge, and liner material, as well as wastewater, sludge, soil, and/or groundwater sampling, impoundment removal, and revegetation. Note that these lists are meant to be illustrative, but are not necessarily inclusive of all costs that may arise.
- Item 9: This request must be signed by an appropriate responsible official for the transferee. By signing, the transferee certifies that all information included in this request is correct to the best of their knowledge.
